**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2173 by House Committee on Commerce, Labor and Economic Development


In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2173 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2173 would prohibit any building codes, ordinances, resolutions, regulations, or rules from banning or limiting the use of refrigerants that are approved by federal law.

The Kansas Association of Counties indicates that HB 2173 could have a fiscal effect on counties. Counties who have building codes, ordinances, resolutions, regulations, or rules that ban or limit the use of refrigerants approved under federal law would be null and void.

The League of Kansas Municipalities and the Kansas Department of Agriculture indicate that HB 2173 would not have a fiscal effect for cities or the agency, respectively.
