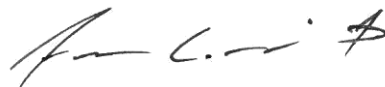
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 431 by Senator Blasi, et al.

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 431 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 431 would require the Capitol Preservation Committee to approve plans to place a permanent memorial honoring the life of Emil Joseph Kapaun. The Secretary of Administration would be authorized to receive moneys from any grants, gifts, contributions, or bequests made for the purpose of financing the creation and construction of the memorial. The bill would establish the Emil Joseph Kapaun Memorial Fund to deposit and expend such funds. No public funds could be expended for the purpose of financing the creation or construction of the memorial.

Legislative Administrative Services indicates enactment of the bill would not have a fiscal effect on the operations of the Legislature. The Department of Administration indicates enactment of the bill would not have a fiscal effect on the agency.
