1 AN ACT making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal years ending  
2 June 30, 2024, June 30, 2025, June 30, 2026, June 30, 2027, and June  
3 30, 2028, for state agencies; authorizing certain transfers and increasing  
4 expenditure limitations to the foregoing; funding of the fiscal year 2024  
5 salary increase for certain state employees; transferring funds from the  
6 legislature employment security fund of the legislative coordinating  
7 council to the university of Kansas and Wichita state university health  
8 collaboration fund of the university of Kansas, the Wichita state  
9 university and university of Kansas health collaboration fund of  
10 Wichita state university and the state general fund; authorizing certain  
11 expenditures from the build Kansas matching grant fund.

15 **BOARD OF ACCOUNTANCY**
