
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2490 by Joint Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice Oversight

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2490 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2490 would establish a maximum case length limit extension for juvenile offenders of 90 days per extension.

The Judiciary, Board of Indigents Defense Services, Department of Corrections, Sentencing Commission, and the Attorney General indicate that enactment of HB 2490 would not have a fiscal effect.
