
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 24 by Senate Committee on Financial Institutions and Insurance

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 24 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 24 would change the definition of large and small employers of group health benefit plans for autism spectrum disorder coverage. "Small employer" would be changed from an employer who employs an average of one but no more than 100 employees to two but no more than 50 employees. "Large employer" would be changed from an average of at least 101 employees to at least 51 employees.

The Kansas Insurance Department, the Kansas Association of Counties, and the League of Kansas Municipalities all state that the bill would not have a fiscal effect.
