
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2099 by House Committee on Insurance

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2099 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2099 concerns the requirement for medical providers to give information on persons covered by their insurance plans to the state. The information is used to identify third party medical coverage of Medicaid recipients. The bill updates the name of the agency receiving this information by replacing the Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services with the Department for Children and Families.

Passage of HB 2099 would have no fiscal effect.
