**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2315 by House Committee on Commerce, Labor and  
Economic Development

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2315 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2315 would define “trespasser” and clarify that the possessor of real property could use justifiable force to repel a trespasser who has entered land or a building with the intent to commit a crime. The bill would clarify that the possessor could be liable for physical injury or death to a child trespasser if specific conditions described in the bill exist.

The Office of Judicial Administration states that the passage of HB 2315 would have no fiscal effect.
