SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2341 by House Committee on Commerce, Labor and Economic Development

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2341 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Current law requires depositions in Kansas to be taken before officers or persons authorized to administer oaths and persons who are certified as court reporters by the Kansas Supreme Court. HB 2341 would add persons who hold a valid and unrevoked certificate as a certified shorthand reporter or certified court reporter issued under the laws of any other state or territory of the United States as persons before whom depositions can be taken.

According to the Office of Judicial Administration, passage of HB 2341 would have no fiscal effect.
