
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 249 by Senator Faust-Goudeau

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 249 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, individuals performing hair braiding within a cosmetology establishment must be a licensed cosmetologist. SB 249 would allow unlicensed individuals to perform hair braiding within a cosmetology establishment.

The Board of Cosmetology and the Kansas Department of Health and Environment indicate enactment of SB 249 would have no fiscal effect on either agency's operations.
