SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 300 by Senate Committee on Natural Resources


In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 300 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, any person who desires to take sand from any river owned by the State of Kansas must obtain consent from the Director of Taxation of the Kansas Department of Revenue and pay a royalty of \$0.15 per ton removed. SB 300 would double the sand royalty to \$0.30 per ton.
