SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 35 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 35 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 35 would amend current law to prohibit licensees under the Club and Drinking Establishment Act from knowingly employing or continuing to employ anyone who has been convicted of a person or drug felony, or as a sex offender as defined in K.S.A. 22-4902 to serve liquor.

In addition, licensees would be prohibited from knowingly employing or continuing to employ anyone who has been found guilty of three or more liquor laws within the past five years. Under current law, licensees are prohibited from hiring individuals who have been found guilty of one liquor violation within the past two years.

The Department of Revenue indicates that SB 35 would no fiscal effect on state revenues or expenditures.
