
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 446 by Senate Committee on Ways and Means

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 446 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 446 would amend the Club and Drinking Establishment Act by allowing a city to establish a designated area where alcoholic liquor may be consumed on public streets, alleys, roads, sidewalks, highways, parks and such other open public lands located within that area.

The Department of Revenue indicates that SB 446 would have no fiscal effect on state revenues or expenditures. The League of Kansas Municipalities indicates that SB 446 would have an unknown fiscal effect upon Kansas cities.
