1 AN ACT concerning hair braiding; amending K.S.A. 65-1928 and
2 repealing the existing section.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. K.S.A. 65-1928 is hereby amended to read as follows: 65-
6 1928. (a) The secretary of health and environment shall develop a
7 brochure containing information about infection control techniques which
8 are appropriate for hair braiding *whether within or* outside the salon
9 setting. This brochure shall be made available through the department of
10 health and environment's website or by mail, upon request, for a fee to
11 cover the department of health and environment's printing costs.

12 (b) The brochure shall contain a self-test with questions on the
13 information contained in the brochure. For an individual engaged in hair
14 braiding to be exempt from the practice of cosmetology under K.S.A. 65-
15 1901, and amendments thereto, such individual shall complete the self-test
16 part of the brochure and keep the brochure and completed self-test
17 available at the location at which the individual is braiding hair.

18 (c) *Nothing in this section, in the provisions of article 19 of chapter*
19 *65 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto, or in the*
20 *provisions of article 27 of chapter 74 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated,*
21 *and amendments thereto, shall be construed to prohibit the providing of*
22 *hair braiding services in a salon by an individual who is exempt from the*
23 *practice of cosmetology under subsection (d)(2) of K.S.A. 65-1901, and*
24 *amendments thereto, and in accordance with the requirements of this*
25 *section.*

26 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 65-1928 is hereby repealed.

27 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
28 publication in the statute book.
