1 AN ACT concerning health and human sexuality education; school
2 districts' policies and procedures.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. (a) No board of education of any unified school district
6 shall provide instruction on health and human sexuality to a student, unless
7 written consent has been received from the parent or legal guardian of
8 such student, clearly stating that such parent or legal guardian allows such
9 student to participate in the health and human sexuality education class.

10 (b) The board of education of each unified school district shall
11 provide all instructional materials on health and human sexuality,
12 including any teaching plans and syllabi to any parent or legal guardian
13 who requests such materials before such parent or legal guardian makes a
14 decision of whether to allow such student to be provided such instruction.

15 (c) The board of education of each unified school district shall adopt
16 policies and procedures relating to the instruction of health and human
17 sexuality, including, but not limited to, prohibiting the display or
18 distribution of instructional materials on health and human sexuality to any
19 student whose parent or legal guardian has not given written consent as
20 required in subsection (b).

21 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
22 publication in the statute book.
