SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2298 by House Committee on Health and Human Services

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2298 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2298 would amend existing law to increase the current ceiling on fees that the Board of Barbering is authorized to charge by 50.0 percent.

Enactment of HB 2298 would have no direct fiscal effect on the Board of Barbering, but would allow the agency to increase fees. In order to continue current operations, the agency indicates that it must increase fees, although it is unable to estimate what that increase would amount to. The Division of the Budget reports that the expenditures the Board included in its FY 2018 and FY 2019 budgets depend on revenues that are 33.0 percent more than the FY 2016 actual revenues.
