**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 113 by Senate Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 113 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 113 would amend the Kansas Criminal Code to make the penalty for the crime of burglary of a dwelling with intent to commit a felony, theft, or sexually motivated crime a severity level 7, person felony. It is currently classified a severity level 7, nonperson felony.

The Office of Judicial Administration indicates SB 113 would have no fiscal effect on Judicial Branch operations. The Kansas Sentencing Commission indicates SB 113 would have no fiscal effect on prison admissions or bed space, or the journal entry workload of the Commission.
