SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 262 by Senators Bowers and Hardy

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 262 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 262 would authorize the Capitol Preservation Committee to approved plans to place a permanent statue of Dwight D. Eisenhower on the Kansas Capitol grounds. The Department of Administration may receive monies from grants, gifts, contributions or bequests to finance the construction of the statue and its pedestal. All funds received would be remitted to the Dwight D. Eisenhower Statute Fund, which would be created by the bill. No public funds would be used to construct the statue and pedestal.

According to the Kansas State Historical Society, the statue is estimated to cost approximately \$90,000. The Department of Administration estimates the cost for a solid granite base and for setting the statute would be approximately \$37,500. No state funds would be used to finance these costs. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 262 is not reflected in *The FY 2019 Governor's Budget Report*.
