SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 5 by Senator Faust-Goudeau

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 5 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, one of the conditions for qualifying for restricted driving privileges is an individual must not have previously received a stayed suspension as a result of a conviction for driving with a suspended license. SB 5 would eliminate this condition.

The Department of Revenue states that passage of SB 5 would have no fiscal effect. The Department indicates the bill would require the agency to update forms and training materials, but these tasks can be accomplished within current workloads.
