1 AN ACT regulating traffic; concerning the overtaking and passing of
2 school buses, cameras, penalties; amending K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 8-1556,
3 8-2106 and 8-2118 and repealing the existing sections.
4

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 8-1556 is hereby amended to read as
7 follows: 8-1556. (a) The driver of a vehicle meeting or overtaking from
8 either direction any school bus stopped on the highway shall stop before
9 reaching such school bus when there is in operation on the school bus the
10 flashing red lights specified in ~~subsection (a) of~~ K.S.A. 8-1730(a), and
11 amendments thereto, and the driver shall not proceed until such school bus
12 resumes motion or the flashing red lights and the stop signal arm are no
13 longer actuated.

14 (b) Every school bus shall be equipped with red visual signals
15 meeting the requirements of ~~subsection (a) of~~ K.S.A. 8-1730(a), and
16 amendments thereto, which may be actuated by the driver of the school
17 bus whenever but only whenever such vehicle is stopped on the highway
18 for the purpose of receiving or discharging school children. A school bus
19 driver shall not actuate the special visual signals:

20 (1) At intersections or other places where traffic is controlled by
21 traffic-control signals or police officers; or

22 (2) in designated school bus loading areas where the bus is entirely
23 off the roadway.

24 (c) Every school bus shall bear upon the front and rear thereof plainly
25 visible signs containing the words "school bus" in letters not less than
26 eight inches in height.

27 When a school bus is being operated upon a highway for purposes
28 other than the actual transportation of children either to or from school or
29 to or from interschool or intraschool functions or activities, or for
30 maintenance, repair or storage purposes all markings thereon indicating
31 "school bus" shall be covered or concealed.

32 (d) The driver of a vehicle upon a highway with separate roadways
33 need not stop upon meeting or passing a school bus which is on a different
34 roadway or when upon a controlled-access highway and the school bus is
35 stopped in a loading zone which is a part of or adjacent to such highway
36 and where pedestrians are not permitted to cross the roadway.

1 (e) (1) *As used in this subsection, the term:*

2 (A) *"Owner" means the registrant of a motor vehicle, except that*
3 *such term shall not include a motor vehicle rental company when a motor*
4 *vehicle registered by such company is being operated by another person*
5 *under a rental agreement with such company.*

6 (B) *"Recorded images" means images recorded by a video recording*
7 *device mounted on a school bus with a clear view of vehicles passing the*
8 *bus on either side and showing the date and time the recording was made*
9 *and an electronic symbol showing the activation of amber lights, flashing*
10 *red lights, stop arms fully extended and brakes.*

11 (C) *"Video recording device" means a camera capable of recording*
12 *digital images showing the date and time that the images were recorded.*

13 (2) *A school board may equip school buses with a video recording*
14 *device to enforce subsection (a).*

15 (3) *A copy of the recorded images showing that a person operated a*
16 *motor vehicle in violation of subsection (a) shall be included with the*
17 *citation delivered to an owner pursuant to K.S.A. 8-2106, and amendments*
18 *thereto.*

19 (4) *Recorded images made for purposes of this subsection shall not*
20 *be subject to the open records act, K.S.A. 45-215 et seq., and amendments*
21 *thereto. The provisions of this paragraph shall expire on July 1, 2022,*
22 *unless the legislature reviews and reenacts this provisions pursuant to*
23 *K.S.A. 45-229, and amendments thereto, prior to July 1, 2022.*

24 (5) *No additional citation shall be imposed under this subsection on*
25 *the owner of a motor vehicle if the operator of the vehicle was arrested or*
26 *issued a citation and notice to appear by a police officer for the same*
27 *violation.*

28 (6) *A school district may enter into an intergovernmental agreement*
29 *to offset expenses regarding the implementation and ongoing operation of*
30 *video recording devices serving the purpose of capturing recorded images*
31 *of motor vehicles unlawfully passing a school bus.*

32 (f) *The provisions of this section shall be subject to the provisions*
33 *contained in K.S.A. 8-2009a, and amendments thereto.*

34 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 8-2106 is hereby amended to read as
35 follows: 8-2106. (a) A law enforcement officer may prepare and deliver to
36 a person a written traffic citation on a form approved by the division of
37 motor vehicles, if the law enforcement officer stops the person for a
38 violation of:

39 (1) *The uniform act regulating traffic on highways, which violation is*
40 *a misdemeanor or a traffic infraction;*

41 (2) *K.S.A. 8-262, 8-287, 8-2,144, 8-1599, 40-3104, 40-3106, 41-715,*
42 *41-724, 41-727, 47-607, 66-1,111, 66-1,129, 66-1,139, 66-1,140, 66-273,*

4 (3) K.S.A. 31-155, and amendments thereto, involving transportation
5 of bottle rockets;

6 (4) K.S.A. 66-1314 or 66-1328, and amendments thereto, and any
7 rules and regulations adopted pursuant thereto;

8 (5) any rules and regulations adopted pursuant to K.S.A. 2-1212, 68-
9 2001 or 31-146, and amendments thereto;

10 (6) any rules and regulations adopted pursuant to K.S.A. 31-133, and
11 amendments, thereto relating to transportation of materials or fuel; ~~or~~

12 (7) K.S.A. 8-1343 through 8-1347, and amendments thereto, relating
13 to the child passenger safety act; or

14 (8) K.S.A. 8-2501 through 8-2507, and amendments thereto, relating
15 to the safety belt use act.

16 (b) The citation shall contain a notice to appear in court, the name and
17 address of the person, the type of vehicle the person was driving, whether
18 hazardous materials were being transported, whether an accident occurred,
19 the state registration number of the person's vehicle, if any, a statement
20 whether the vehicle is a commercial vehicle, whether the person is
21 licensed to drive a commercial motor vehicle, the offense or offenses
22 charged, the time and place when and where the person shall appear in
23 court, the signature of the law enforcement officer, and any other pertinent
24 information.

25 (c) The time specified in the notice to appear shall be at least five
26 days after the alleged violation unless the person charged with the
27 violation demands an earlier hearing.

28 (d) The place specified in the notice to appear shall be before a judge
29 of the district court within the county in which the offense is alleged to
30 have been committed.

31 (e) Except in the circumstances to which ~~subsection (a) of~~ K.S.A. 8-
32 2104(a), and amendments thereto, apply, in the discretion of the law
33 enforcement officer, a person charged with a misdemeanor may give
34 written promise to appear in court by signing at least one copy of the
35 written citation prepared by the law enforcement officer, in which event
36 the law enforcement officer shall deliver a copy of the citation to the
37 person and shall not take the person into physical custody.

38 (f) When a person is charged with a traffic infraction, the notice to
39 appear shall provide a place where the person may make a written entry of
40 appearance, waive the right to a trial and plead guilty or no contest. Such
41 notice to appear shall contain a provision that the person's failure to either
42 pay such fine and court costs or appear at the specified time may result in
43 suspension of the person's drivers' license as provided in K.S.A. 8-2110,

1 and amendments thereto. The notice to appear shall provide a space where
2 the law enforcement officer shall enter the appropriate fine specified in the
3 uniform fine schedule contained in K.S.A. 8-2118, and amendments
4 thereto, for the violation charged and court costs in the amount provided
5 by law. If the notice to appear does not do so, the law enforcement officer
6 shall provide a person charged with a traffic infraction a form explaining
7 the person's right to appear and right to a trial and the person's right to pay
8 the appropriate fine and court costs prior to the appearance date. The law
9 enforcement officer shall provide the person with the address of the court
10 to which the written entry of appearance, waiver of trial, plea of guilty or
11 no contest and payment of fine and court costs shall be mailed.

12 (g) Any officer violating any of the provisions of subsection (f) is
13 guilty of misconduct in office and shall be subject to removal from office.

14 (h) *A law enforcement officer shall **prepare and deliver the written***
15 *traffic citation to a person charged with a violation of K.S.A. 8-1556, and*
16 *amendments thereto, evidenced by a recorded image—~~and sent~~. **Such***
17 ***citation may be served on such person in any manner authorized by***
18 ***law, including, but not limited to, mailing it by certified mail to the last***
19 ***known address of the person.***

20 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 8-2118 is hereby amended to read as
21 follows: 8-2118. (a) A person charged with a traffic infraction shall, except
22 as provided in subsection (b), appear at the place and time specified in the
23 notice to appear. If the person enters an appearance, waives right to trial,
24 pleads guilty or no contest, the fine shall be no greater than that specified
25 in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs shall be
26 taxed as provided by law.

27 (b) Prior to the time specified in the notice to appear, a person
28 charged with a traffic infraction may enter a written appearance, waive
29 right to trial, plead guilty or no contest and pay the fine for the violation as
30 specified in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs
31 provided by law. Payment may be made in any manner accepted by the
32 court. The traffic citation shall not have been complied with if the payment
33 is not honored for any reason, or if the fine and court costs are not paid in
34 full. When a person charged with a traffic infraction makes payment
35 without executing a written waiver of right to trial and plea of guilty or no
36 contest, the payment shall be deemed such an appearance, waiver of right
37 to trial and plea of no contest.

38 (c) The following uniform fine schedule shall apply uniformly
39 throughout the state but shall not limit the fine which may be imposed
40 following a court appearance, except an appearance made for the purpose
41 of pleading and payment as permitted by subsection (a). The description of
42 offense contained in the following uniform fine schedule is for reference
43 only and is not a legal definition.

5 (d) Traffic offenses classified as traffic infractions by this section
6 shall be classified as ordinance traffic infractions by those cities adopting
7 ordinances prohibiting the same offenses. A schedule of fines for all
8 ordinance traffic infractions shall be established by the municipal judge in
9 the manner prescribed by K.S.A. 12-4305, and amendments thereto. Such
10 fines may vary from those contained in the uniform fine schedule
11 contained in subsection (c).

12 (e) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection
13 (c) shall be doubled if a person is convicted of a traffic infraction, which is
14 defined as a moving violation in accordance with rules and regulations
15 adopted pursuant to K.S.A. 8-249, and amendments thereto, committed
16 within any road construction zone as defined in K.S.A. 8-1458a, and
17 amendments thereto.

18 (f) For a second violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and
19 amendments thereto, within two years after a prior conviction of K.S.A. 8-
20 1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction
21 shall be fined 1½ times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of
22 the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection
23 (c). For a third violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments
24 thereto, within two years, after two prior convictions of K.S.A. 8-1908 or
25 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction shall be
26 fined two times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of the
27 schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c).
28 For a fourth and each succeeding violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909,
29 and amendments thereto, within two years after three prior convictions of
30 K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon
31 conviction shall be fined 2½ times the applicable amount from one, but
32 not both, of the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in
33 subsection (c).
