

HOUSE BILL No. 2662

1 AN ACT concerning the Kansas board of barbering; relating to fees;
2 increasing the fees for licenses and examinations; amending K.S.A.
3 2017 Supp. 65-1817 and repealing the existing section.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 65-1817 is hereby amended to read as
7 follows: 65-1817. (a) In each fiscal year, the board shall determine the
8 amount of funds which that will be required during the next ensuing fiscal
9 year to properly administer the laws which that the board is directed to
10 enforce and administer and shall fix fees in accordance with this section
11 for such ensuing year in such reasonable sums as may be necessary for
12 such purposes.

13 (b) After fixing such fees, the board may charge and collect the fees,
14 in advance for the following purposes, subject to the following limitations:

- 15 For examination of applicant to practice barbering—not more
16 than.....\$100\$200
17 For issuance of license to practice barbering—not more
18 than.....80150
19 For renewal of license to practice barbering—not more
20 than.....80150
21 For restoration of expired license to practice barbering, if
22 expiration period is under three years, the lapsed fees
23 plus a restoration fee of not more than.....400525
24 After three years applicant shall be reexamined upon pay-
25 ment of the regular examination fee—not more than.....400200
26 For instructors license or annual renewal thereof—not more
27 than.....90150
28 For restoration of expired instructors license, if expiration
29 period is under three years, the lapsed fees plus a
30 restoration fee of not more than.....90450
31 After three years the instructor shall be reexamined upon
32 payment of the regular examination fee—not more than.....470200
33 For a license to operate a barber school or barber college,
34 annual fee—not more than.....500750
35 For shop inspection, and annual license fee—not more than.....40100
36 For restoration of expired shop license, if expiration period is

1 under three years, the lapsed fee plus a restoration fee of
2 not more than.....~~80~~500
3 For a new shop, relocation or change of ownership—not more
4 than.....~~80~~150
5 For issuance of a seminar permit—not more than.....~~80~~120
6 For issuance of student learning license—not more than.....~~55~~100

7 (c) A duplicate license will be issued upon the filing of a statement
8 covering the loss of same and the payment of a fee of \$5 for the issuance
9 of same. Each duplicate shall have the word "duplicate" stamped across
10 the face thereof and will bear the same number as the original.

11 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 65-1817 is hereby repealed.

12 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
13 publication in the statute book.
