

SENATE BILL No. 144

1 AN ACT regulating traffic; concerning the operation of a motor vehicle in
2 a school zone and a road construction zone; use of a wireless
3 communication device; amending K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 8-2118 and
4 repealing the existing section.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 New Section 1. (a) As used in this section:

8 (1) "Hands-free device" means speakerphone capability or a
9 telephone attachment or other piece of equipment, regardless of whether
10 permanently installed in the motor vehicle, that allows use of the wireless
11 communication device without use of either of the operator's hands.

12 (2) "Wireless communication device" has the same meaning as
13 defined in K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 8-15,111, and amendments thereto.

14 (b) On and after January 1, 2018, no person shall operate a motor
15 vehicle in a school zone established by K.S.A. 8-1560(a) or K.S.A. 2016
16 Supp. 8-1560e, and amendments thereto, or a road construction zone, as
17 that term is defined in K.S.A. 8-1458a, and amendments thereto, while
18 using a wireless communication device.

19 (c) The provisions of subsection (b) shall not apply to:

20 (1) A law enforcement officer or emergency service personnel acting
21 within the course and scope of the law enforcement officer's or emergency
22 service personnel's employment;

23 (2) a motor vehicle that is stopped; or

24 (3) a wireless communication device that is being used with a hands-
25 free device.

26 (d) The provisions of subsection (b) shall not prohibit a person from
27 using a wireless communication device while operating a motor vehicle in
28 a school zone or road construction zone to:

29 (1) Report current or ongoing illegal activity to law enforcement;

30 (2) prevent imminent injury to a person or property; or

31 (3) summon medical or other emergency assistance.

32 (e) Any conviction under the provisions of this section shall not be
33 construed as a moving traffic violation for the purpose of K.S.A. 8-255,
34 and amendments thereto.

35 (f) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the uniform act
36 regulating traffic on highways.

1 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 8-2118 is hereby amended to read as
 2 follows: 8-2118. (a) A person charged with a traffic infraction shall, except
 3 as provided in subsection (b), appear at the place and time specified in the
 4 notice to appear. If the person enters an appearance, waives right to trial,
 5 pleads guilty or no contest, the fine shall be no greater than that specified
 6 in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs shall be
 7 taxed as provided by law.

8 (b) Prior to the time specified in the notice to appear, a person
 9 charged with a traffic infraction may enter a written appearance, waive
 10 right to trial, plead guilty or no contest and pay the fine for the violation as
 11 specified in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs
 12 provided by law. Payment may be made in any manner accepted by the
 13 court. The traffic citation shall not have been complied with if the payment
 14 is not honored for any reason, or if the fine and court costs are not paid in
 15 full. When a person charged with a traffic infraction makes payment
 16 without executing a written waiver of right to trial and plea of guilty or no
 17 contest, the payment shall be deemed such an appearance, waiver of right
 18 to trial and plea of no contest.

19 (c) The following uniform fine schedule shall apply uniformly
 20 throughout the state but shall not limit the fine which may be imposed
 21 following a court appearance, except an appearance made for the purpose
 22 of pleading and payment as permitted by subsection (a). The description of
 23 offense contained in the following uniform fine schedule is for reference
 24 only and is not a legal definition.

32 (d) Traffic offenses classified as traffic infractions by this section
 33 shall be classified as ordinance traffic infractions by those cities adopting
 34 ordinances prohibiting the same offenses. A schedule of fines for all
 35 ordinance traffic infractions shall be established by the municipal judge in
 36 the manner prescribed by K.S.A. 12-4305, and amendments thereto. Such
 37 fines may vary from those contained in the uniform fine schedule
 38 contained in subsection (c).

39 (e) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection
 40 (c) shall be doubled if a person is convicted of a traffic infraction, which is
 41 defined as a moving violation in accordance with rules and regulations
 42 adopted pursuant to K.S.A. 8-249, and amendments thereto, committed
 43 within any road construction zone as defined in K.S.A. 8-1458a, and

1 amendments thereto.

2 (f) For a second violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and
3 amendments thereto, within two years after a prior conviction of K.S.A. 8-
4 1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction
5 shall be fined $1\frac{1}{2}$ times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of
6 the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection
7 (c). For a third violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments
8 thereto, within two years, after two prior convictions of K.S.A. 8-1908 or
9 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction shall be
10 fined two times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of the
11 schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c).
12 For a fourth and each succeeding violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909,
13 and amendments thereto, within two years after three prior convictions of
14 K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon
15 conviction shall be fined $2\frac{1}{2}$ times the applicable amount from one, but not
16 both, of the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in
17 subsection (c).

18 (g) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection
19 (c) relating to exceeding the maximum speed limit, shall be doubled if a
20 person is convicted of exceeding the maximum speed limit in a school
21 zone authorized under ~~subsection (a)(4)~~ of K.S.A. 8-1560(a)(4), and
22 amendments thereto.

23 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 8-2118 is hereby repealed.

24 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
25 publication in the statute book.
