15 16 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

- Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding any other laws to the contrary, an emergency vehicle may operate at a gross weight not exceeding 86,000 pounds, subject to a maximum weight of:
 - (1) 24,000 pounds on a single steering axle;
 - (2) 33,500 pounds on a single drive axle;
- (3) 62,000 pounds on a tandem axle;
 - (4) 52,000 pounds on a tandem rear drive steer axle.
- 12 (b) As used in this section, "emergency vehicle" means a vehicle designed to be used under emergency conditions to:
 - (1) Transport personnel and equipment; and
 - (2) support the suppression of fires and mitigation of other hazardous situations.
- 17 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
