MR. PRESIDENT:

I move to amend **Senate Substitute for HB 2056**, on page 1, by striking all in lines 9 through 36;

By striking all on pages 2 through 9;

On page 10, by striking all in lines 1 through 39; following line 39, by inserting:

"Section 1. (a) A member of the senate shall not be eligible for election to a third or any subsequent consecutive term of office if such member does not satisfy the contribution threshold during such member's term of office that immediately precedes the term during which such member would file for election for such office.

- (b) A member of the house of representatives shall not be eligible for election to a fourth or any subsequent consecutive term of office if such member does not satisfy the contribution threshold during such member's term that immediately precedes the term during which such member would file for election for such office.
- (c) The governmental ethics commission shall determine if members of the senate and the house of representatives satisfy the contribution threshold. On or before March 10 of the year following a senator's election to a second or subsequent consecutive term or a representative's election to a third or subsequent consecutive term, the commission shall notify any member who failed to satisfy the contribution threshold. A member receiving such notice may appeal the commission's determination and request a hearing. The request for an appeal and a hearing shall be submitted in such form and manner as prescribed by the commission. If there is no appeal requested or the commission determines a member failed to satisfy the contribution threshold

after consideration of an appeal, the commission shall notify the secretary of state that such member failed to satisfy the contribution threshold. A copy of such notice shall also be sent to such member at the time it is submitted to the secretary of state.

- (d) As used in this section:
- (1) "Contribution" means the same as defined in K.S.A. 25-4143, and amendments thereto.
- (2) "Contribution threshold" means, of the aggregate amount of contributions received by the candidate for the applicable period of time, an amount that is not less than 70% of such aggregate amount is received from individuals.";

Also on page 10, in line 41, by striking "Kansas register" and inserting "statute book"; And by renumbering sections accordingly;

On page 1, in the title, in line 1, by striking all after "concerning"; by striking all in lines 2 through 5; in line 6, by striking all before the period and inserting "members of the legislature; relating to term limits; restricting eligibility for reelection based on certain campaign finance contribution thresholds"
