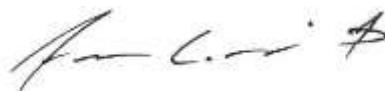
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2124 by House Committee on Education

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2124 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2124 would clarify the authority of healing arts school clinics to provide healing arts services. The bill would exempt healing arts school clinics from the prohibition against a non-professional business engaging in the practice of healing arts. The bill would also allow for offsite clinics owned or operated by a school in partnership with other providers to engage in the practice of healing arts.

The Kansas State Board of Healing Arts indicates that enactment of HB 2124 would have no fiscal effect.
