
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2390 by House Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2390 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2390 would make exceptions to the Kansas Open Records Act that would otherwise expire July 1, 2021 permanent. The bill would also remove the requirement for legislative review of those exceptions prior to July 1, 2021.

The bill would not have a fiscal effect.
