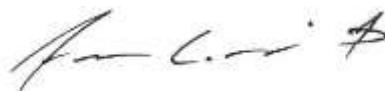
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2505 by House Committee on Education

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2505 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2505 would require school districts to notify parents in writing of the intent to administer a college and career readiness assessment questionnaire or survey to any student enrolled in kindergarten through grade 12. A parent would have the opportunity to decline a student's participation; however, no permission by the parent would be needed to administer the questionnaire or survey.

The Department of Education states that the enactment of HB 2505 would have no fiscal effect.
