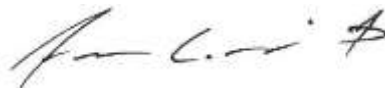
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2511 by House Committee on K-12 Education Budget

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2511 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2511 would allow residents of a school district who are enrolled in a virtual school or in any private nonaccredited school to participate in any activities supervised by the Kansas State High School Athletics Association (KSHSAA), if the student meets other participation requirements, as outlined by the bill. In addition, the bill would add members or individuals employed by the KSHSAA to be mandatory reporters of child abuse and neglect.

The Department of Education states that the enactment of HB 2511 would have no effect on state aid to school districts. Any fiscal effect would be borne by school districts that would be affected by the bill.
