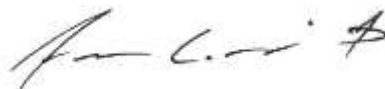
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2601 by House Committee on Appropriations

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2601 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2601 would authorize the State Board of Regents, on behalf of Kansas State University (KSU), to sell and convey all the rights, title, and interest subject to all easements and appurtenances in certain real estate located in Riley County and Cherokee County, Kansas and Douglas County, Nebraska. HB 2601 would take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the *Kansas Register*.

With the enactment of HB 2601, KSU would retain the proceeds from the sale of the property; however, a revenue estimate from the sale currently is not available. In addition, once the property is sold, KSU would no longer incur costs to maintain the property. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2601 is not reflected in *The FY 2023 Governor's Budget Report*.
