
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2643 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2643 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2643 would prohibit sexually oriented businesses from obtaining a club and drinking establishment license and would prohibit the sale or consumption of alcohol or cereal malt beverage on such business premises.

The Department of Revenue indicates that enactment of the bill would have a negligible fiscal effect that could be absorbed within existing resources. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2643 is not reflected in *The FY 2023 Governor's Budget Report*.
