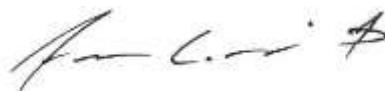
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2669 by Representatives Lee and Garber

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2669 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2669 would modify immunization requirements and exemptions for religious beliefs as it relates to schools and childcare facilities. The bill would require schools and childcare facilities to grant religious exemptions from vaccination requirements without inquiring into the sincerity of the religious beliefs.

The Department for Children and Families, the Kansas State Department of Education, and the Kansas Department of Health and Environment indicate that HB 2669 would have no fiscal effect on the agencies.
