
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 158 by Senate Committee on Transportation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 158 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 158 would prohibit a person providing towing services from towing a vehicle to a location outside of Kansas without the consent of the driver or owner of the vehicle or without the consent of a motor club of which the driver or owner is a member. The bill would also require person intending to sell any vehicle that cannot be verified by the Division of Vehicles to obtain an interstate search of registered owners and lienholders unless the vehicle is 10 years of age or older or the vehicle is determined by the Division of Vehicles to be a nonrepairable vehicle. The bill also makes various technical corrections.

The Department of Revenue indicates enactment of the bill would have a negligible fiscal effect that could be absorbed within existing resources.
