1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION relating to the adjournment of the
2 senate and house of representatives for a period of time during the
3 2022 regular session of the legislature.

5 *Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Kansas, the*
6 *Senate concurring therein:* That the legislature shall adjourn at the
7 close of business of the daily session convened on April 28, 2022, and
8 shall reconvene on May 23, 2022, to conduct all legislative matters
9 and to review and respond to any final decision or order issued by the
10 Kansas Supreme Court in the case of Rivera v. Schwab regarding the
11 constitutionality of the reapportioned United States Congressional
12 districts enacted in 2022 Substitute for Senate Bill No. 355; and

13 *Be it further resolved:* That the chief clerk of the house of representatives
14 and the secretary of the senate and employees specified by the director
15 of legislative administrative services for such purpose shall attend to
16 their duties each day during periods of adjournment, Sundays
17 excepted, for the purpose of receiving messages from the governor
18 and conducting such other business as may be required; and

19 *Be it further resolved:* That members of the legislature shall not receive
20 the per diem compensation and subsistence allowances provided for in
21 K.S.A. 46-137a(a) and (b), and amendments thereto, for any day
22 within a period in which both houses of the legislature are adjourned
23 for more than two days, Sundays excepted; and

24 *Be it further resolved:* That members of the legislature attending a
25 legislative meeting of whatever nature when authorized pursuant to
26 law, or by the legislative coordinating council, the president of the
27 senate or the speaker of the house of representatives, and members of
28 a conference committee attending a meeting of the conference
29 committee authorized by the president of the senate and the speaker of
30 the house of representatives during any period of adjournment for
31 which members are not authorized compensation and allowances
32 pursuant to K.S.A. 46-137a, and amendments thereto, shall receive
33 compensation, subsistence allowances, mileage and other expenses in
34 amounts prescribed under K.S.A. 75-3212, and amendments thereto.
