**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2199 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2199 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2199 would allow board of county commissioners to regulate the granting of conservation easements on property located within the county. If the property is located in more than one county, the respective county boards must agree on each regulation pertaining to the property.

The League of Kansas Municipalities indicates the bill would have no fiscal effect on Kansas cities and the Kansas Association of Counties indicates the bill would have no fiscal effect on Kansas counties.
