
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2585 by House Committee on Energy, Utilities and Telecommunications

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2585 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2585 would exempt the retail sale by public utilities of electricity for electric vehicle charging stations from the jurisdiction of the Kansas Corporation Commission.

Both the KCC and the Kansas Department of Revenue report that enactment of HB 2585 would have no fiscal effect on agency operations. The League of Kansas Municipalities states that enactment of this bill would have little or no effect on city finances.
