SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 418 by Senator Holland and Senator Peterson

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 418 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Currently, the Joint Committee on Information Technology may meet at any time and at any place within the state on call of the chairperson. SB 418 would require the Joint Committee to meet monthly on call of the chairperson.

The Legislative Coordinating Council indicates the Joint Committee currently averages five meetings per year and increasing the number of meetings to 12 would increase annual expenditures for the Kansas Legislature by \$43,912 which includes \$41,545 for legislator salary, travel and subsistence, and \$2,367 for committee assistants. This estimate assumes rates remain the same on and after July 1, 2020 as during 2020 Legislative Session. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 418 is not reflected in *The FY 2021 Governor's Budget Report*.
