1 AN ACT concerning wildlife, parks and tourism; relating to fees;
2 amending K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 32-988 and repealing the existing section.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 32-988 is hereby amended to read as
6 follows: 32-988. (a) The secretary is authorized to adopt, in accordance
7 with K.S.A. 32-805, and amendments thereto, rules and regulations fixing
8 the amount of fees for the following items, subject to the following
9 limitations and subject to the requirement that no such rules and
10 regulations shall be adopted as temporary rules and regulations:

11 Big game permits

12 Resident (other than elk permit): maximum \$100

13 Nonresident (other than elk permit): maximum ~~\$400~~ \$600

14 Elk permit: maximum ~~\$350~~ \$500

15 Nonresident mule deer stamp: maximum ~~\$150~~ \$250

16 Nonresident applications: maximum ~~\$25~~ \$40

17 Combination hunting and fishing licenses

18 Resident: maximum ~~\$50~~ \$100

19 Lifetime: maximum ~~\$1,000~~ \$1,500; or 8 quarterly payments, each
20 maximum ~~\$150~~ \$187.50

21 Nonresident: maximum ~~\$200~~ \$300

22 Commercial dog training permits: maximum \$25

23 ~~Commercial guide permit or associate guide permit~~

24 ~~Resident: maximum \$250~~

25 ~~Nonresident: maximum \$1,000~~

26 Commercial harvest or dealer permits: maximum \$200

27 Commercial prairie rattlesnake harvesting permits

28 Resident or nonresident with valid hunting license: maximum \$5

29 Resident or nonresident nonfirearm without valid hunting license:
30 maximum \$20

31 Controlled shooting area operator license: maximum \$400

- 40 Wildlife damage control permits: maximum \$10
- 41 Wildlife importation permits: maximum ~~\$10~~ \$25

- 43 Resident: maximum \$100

1 Nonresident: maximum \$400

2 Resident turkey tag: maximum ~~\$20~~ \$40

3 Nonresident turkey tag: maximum ~~\$30~~ \$60

4 Special permits under K.S.A. 32-961: maximum \$100

5 Miscellaneous fees

6 Special events on department land or water: maximum ~~\$200~~ \$500

7 Special departmental services, materials or supplies: no maximum

8 Other issues of department: no maximum

9 Vendor bond: no maximum

10 (b) The fee for a landowner-tenant resident big game or wild turkey
11 hunting permit shall be an amount equal to $\frac{1}{2}$ the fee for a general resident
12 big game or wild turkey hunting permit.

13 (c) The fee for a big game or wild turkey hunting permit for a resident
14 under 16 years of age shall be an amount not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ the fee for a
15 general resident big game or wild turkey hunting permit.

16 (d) The fee for a furharvester license for a resident under 16 years of
17 age shall be an amount ~~equal to~~ *not to exceed* $\frac{1}{2}$ the fee for a resident
18 furharvester license.

19 (e) For a resident who is at least 65 years of age, but less than 75
20 years of age:

21 (1) The fee for an annual hunting license shall be an amount equal to
22 $\frac{1}{2}$ the fee for a general annual hunting license;

23 (2) the fee for an annual fishing license shall be an amount equal to $\frac{1}{2}$
24 the fee for a general annual fishing license; and

25 (3) the fee for an annual combination hunting and fishing license
26 shall be an amount equal to $\frac{1}{2}$ the fee for a general annual combination
27 hunting and fishing license.

28 (f) The secretary may establish, by rules and regulations adopted in
29 accordance with K.S.A. 32-805, and amendments thereto, different fees for
30 various classes and types of licenses, permits, stamps and other issuances
31 of the department ~~which~~ *that* may occur within each item as described
32 under subsection (a).

33 (g) The provisions of subsection (e) shall expire on June 30, 2020.
