
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2058 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2058 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2058 would allow the state of Kansas to recognize a valid license or permit to carry a concealed firearm issued by another jurisdiction for non-Kansas residents. The bill would also create exemptions in certain criminal statutes for criminal possession of a firearm, if that person has a valid concealed carry permit from another jurisdiction that is recognized by this state.

The Office of the Attorney General states that this bill would have no fiscal effect.
