
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2158 by House Committee on Health and Human Services

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2158 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, the authority of the Advisory Committee on Trauma or a regional trauma council to conduct closed session meetings and keep certain records privileged is set to expire on July 1, 2021. HB 2158 would remove the expiration of this authority.

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment indicates the bill would have no fiscal effect on Department operations, and support for the Kansas Trauma Program would continue within existing resources.
