
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2389 by House Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2389 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2389 would authorize a notice to appear for unlawful possession of marijuana to be deemed a complaint under the Kansas Code of Criminal Procedure.

The Office of Judicial Administration states enactment of HB 2389 would have a negligible fiscal effect on Judicial Branch operations. The Kansas Sentencing Commission states enactment of the bill would have no effect on prison admissions or beds. Both the League of Kansas Municipalities and the Kansas Association of Counties state enactment of the bill would have a negligible fiscal effect to local governments.
