
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2408 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2408 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2408 would authorize the Kansas Historical Society to convey, without consideration, to the Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska all of the rights, title and interest of certain state real property located in Doniphan County, Kansas.

The Kansas Historical Society estimates transferring the Iowa, Sac and Fox Mission property to the Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska would reduce annual expenditures maintenance of the property by \$5,745, of which \$1,200 is from the State General Fund. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2408 is not reflected in *The FY 2022 Governor's Budget Report*.
