SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 209 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs


In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 209 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 209 would amend existing law concerning advance voting ballots to specify the requirements for mailings, including for the documents and envelopes included in the mailings, intended to solicit a registered voter to file an application for an advance voting ballot.

According to the Secretary of State, enactment of SB 209 would require the agency to update training and education materials informing election officials and voters of the change. These actions could be accomplished with existing resources.

The Kansas Association of Counties indicates that enactment of the bill would have no fiscal effect on the counties in Kansas.
