A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION urging the President of the United States to consider current geopolitical tensions and support policies to 2 ensure America's long-term energy affordability, security, leadership 3 4 and progress. 5 WHEREAS, On February 24, 2022, Russia began a full-scale invasion 6 7 of Ukraine; and 8 WHEREAS, The ramifications of this invasion have rippled across the 9 world, leaving economic uncertainty in its wake; and WHEREAS, The world looks to the United States for energy 10 leadership and stability as the current geopolitical events continue to pose 12 economic disruptions at a time when inflation continues to adversely affect households worldwide; and 13 WHEREAS, Energy independence and national security should be a 14 priority, as nothing is more essential to economic growth than reliable, 15 16 affordable and abundant energy; and WHEREAS, Punitive, unnecessary and burdensome regulations on 17 small businesses in the oil and gas industry hinders progress toward 18 energy independence; and 19 20 WHEREAS, America must take a stand and immediately stop importing all oil, gas and biofuels from our country's adversaries: Now, 21 22 therefore. 23 Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Kansas, the House of Representatives concurring therein: That we urge President Biden to 24 reject unscientific environmental mandates that restrict domestic energy 25 production and raise costs for American families; and 26 27 Be it further resolved: That we urge the President of the United States to consider current geopolitical tensions and support policies that ensure 28 America's long-term energy affordability, security, leadership and 29 progress, including actions to increase investment in domestic refineries 30 31 and natural gas production; and
