Subject: HB 2272 Establishing a KPERS working after retirement exemption for retirants employed by a community developmental disability organization in a licensed professional nurse, licensed practical nurse or direct support position.

House Bill No. 2272 establishes a KPERS working after retirement exemption for retirants who are employed as a licensed professional nurse, licensed practical nurse or in a direct support position of a KPERS affiliated community developmental disability organization. Under this exemption, when a CDDO hires a KPERS retirant no employer contribution would be required for such retirant. Working after retirement provisions relating to the waiting period before returning to work and no prearranged agreement for employment would still apply to these positions.

The bill also removes from statute previous working after retirement exceptions that expired January 1, 2018.
