Subject: SB 120—Public Water Supply Systems and Replacement Projects

Senate Bill 120 would authorize the secretary of health and environment to adopt rules and regulations for an annual certification program for the replacement of distribution system segments and increasing the amortization period on loans from the Kansas water pollution control revolving fund.

Section 1 would amend K.S.A. 65-163 to allow the secretary of health and environment to adopt rules and regulations for an annual certification program for the replacement of segments of distribution systems.

Currently, K.S.A. 65-3226 authorizes a maximum of a 20-year repayment period for loans from the Kansas water pollution control revolving loan fund. Section 2 would allow any agreements for loans from the fund entered into after July 1, 2023, to be repaid within 30 years after such date.

SB 120 would take effect on July 1 upon publication in the statute book.
