It is our goal in Deerfield to have every student graduate with a certification in the field or pathway of their interest that will help them be more successful and give them a "leg up" in getting hired in their field of interest. We are a small rural school so certifications in agriculture and machinery are really important for our job market and these certifications are not covered by any education program. As the enrollment in Deerfield grows our goal of making sure students have a certification will come with a larger price tag every year. We will always do what is right and best for all students.
