Madam Chair, members of the committee, thank you for the opportunity to provide testimony for HB 2567.

My name is Adam Turk and I Represent the 117th district and I am a proponent for HB 2567, also known as the EMERGE bill. This bill aims to provide tuition assistance to the dedicated members of the Kansas Army and Air National Guard.
