SB210– Allowing candidates for nonpartisan offices to have such candidate's political party affiliation provided on the ballot with such candidate's name.

Chair Thompson and Members of the Committee,

Thank you for the opportunity to provide opponent testimony on SB210.

Mainstream Coalition OPPOSES SB210.

Our rationale is straightforward:

- Nonpartisan local elections emphasize candidates and communities over party politics.
- Political affiliations are irrelevant to providing services.
- Collaboration between elected officials belonging to different parties is more likely if they
 are not branded by their party.
