I strongly urge you to oppose SB 135.

The push to legalize medical marijuana in the state of Kansas must be stopped. In other states we've seen it play out where the medical marijuana issue has been used as a trojan horse to get past the people, then a few years later recreational marijuana is pushed. The argument that people need it for pain management is a ruse. There are already FDA approved medical THC drugs available to citizens of Kansas.
