Subject: Senate Bill No. 132

Summary

Senate Bill No. 132 provides for a new distinctive license plate – the Buffalo Soldier license plate. The plate would be subject to the 250 initial plate commitment and payment of up to \$5,000 in development costs as such requirements are set forth in K.S.A. 8-1,141. The Richard Allen Cultural Center & Museum, Inc., with the Division of Vehicle's approval, would be able to assist with the design of the plate. Additionally, the Richard Allen Cultural Center & Museum, Inc. would be able to set an annual royalty fee in the amount of \$25 up to \$100 for the plates and such fees would go towards the support of the Richard Allen Cultural Center & Museum, Inc. with a portion of such funds to be dedicated to the construction and maintenance of the Reimagined Frontier Museum.
