AN ACT concerning information technology; relating to online platforms and removal of liability protections therefor; requiring wireless communication device vendors to provide parental notification of application downloads by a minor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of 47 U.S.C. § 230(c) (1), any provider of an online platform shall be treated as the publisher or speaker of information published by a user of such online platform if such provider:

- (1) Knew or should have known such provider used an algorithm to make personalized recommendations to a user of such online platform; and
- (2) such posts materially contributed to a physical or severe emotional injury to such user.
  - (b) As used in this section:
- (1) "Algorithm" means any computational process, model or other automated means of processing to rank, order, promote, recommend, amplify or similarly alter the delivery or display of information.
- (2) "Online platform" means any digital service that facilitates interactions between two or more independent users who interact through the internet.
- (3) "Personalized recommendation" means using an algorithm to enhance the visibility of specific information to a specific user.
- Sec. 2. (a) Upon a parent's purchase and activation of a wireless communication device intended for use by a minor, the wireless communication device vendor shall set such wireless communication device to a default setting that enables a push notification on a parent's wireless communication device alerting the parent that a minor has downloaded an application on the minor's wireless communication device.
  - (b) As used in this section:
- (1) "Application" means a computer software package or packages that performs a specific function for the user.
  - (2) "Minor" means any unmarried person under 18 years of age.
- (3) "Parent" means the parent, guardian, custodian or other person with authority to act on behalf of the minor.
  - (4) "Push notification" means an alert on a parent's wireless

 communication device that notifies the parent that a minor downloaded an application on the minor's wireless communication device and provides the name of such application.

- (5) "Wireless communication device" means any wireless electronic communication device that provides for voice or data communication between two or more parties, including, but not limited to, a mobile or cellular telephone, a text messaging device, a personal digital assistant that sends or receives messages, an audio-video player that sends or receives messages or a laptop computer.
- (6) "Wireless communication device vendor" means any person or entity that is engaged in the sale of a wireless communication device and the provision of wireless services for the use of such device.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
